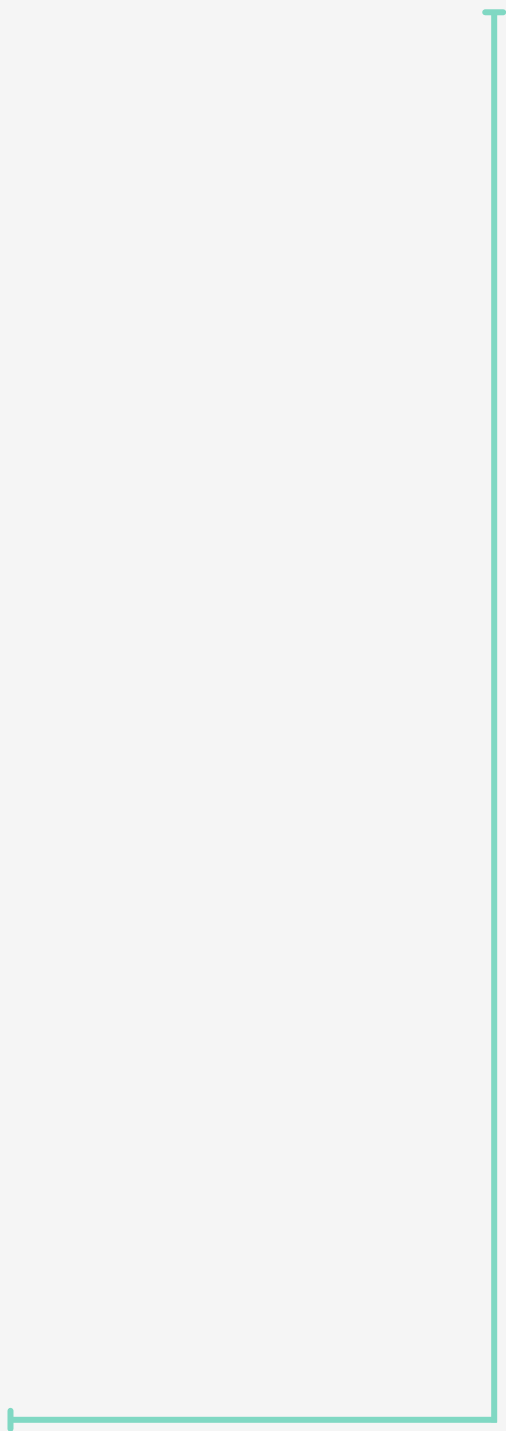

MONDAY: FACE TIME

Day 1: Identity through Surrender - Read Colossians 1:15-20

Colossians 1:15

Paul begins with Jesus. Before we can understand ourselves, we must understand Him. Jesus perfectly reveals God. To see Jesus is to see God! That means your identity does not begin with your feelings, your mistakes, your popularity, your past, or what others think about you.

Identity begins with Christ. Are you surrendered to him? To surrender means you quit a lesser thing and give yourself over to something greater.

Colossians 1:16-17

Jesus created all things, and all things exist through Him and for Him. That includes you. You are not random. You are not meaningless. You were created on purpose and for a purpose. Jesus is the only person worth surrendering to!

Colossians 1:18

Jesus deserves first place in everything because He is above everything. A lot of people try to build an identity around sports, relationships, appearance, success, or attention. Christ should have supremacy over ALL things. When Jesus is not first, we start looking for identity in things that constantly change. Is Jesus first in your life?

Colossians 1:19-20

Jesus also came to rescue and reconcile you. The cross proves your value to God. Your worth is not determined by your failures, your shame, your reputation, or your social status. Christ was willing to shed His blood to rescue you! If you are living your life on your own terms... STOP. Instead, surrender to Jesus who died for your salvation.

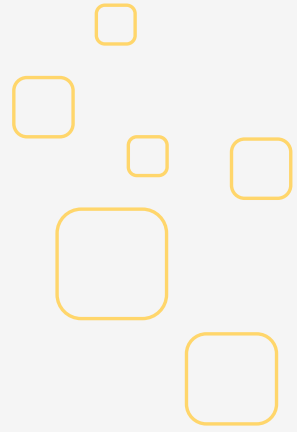
Think About It

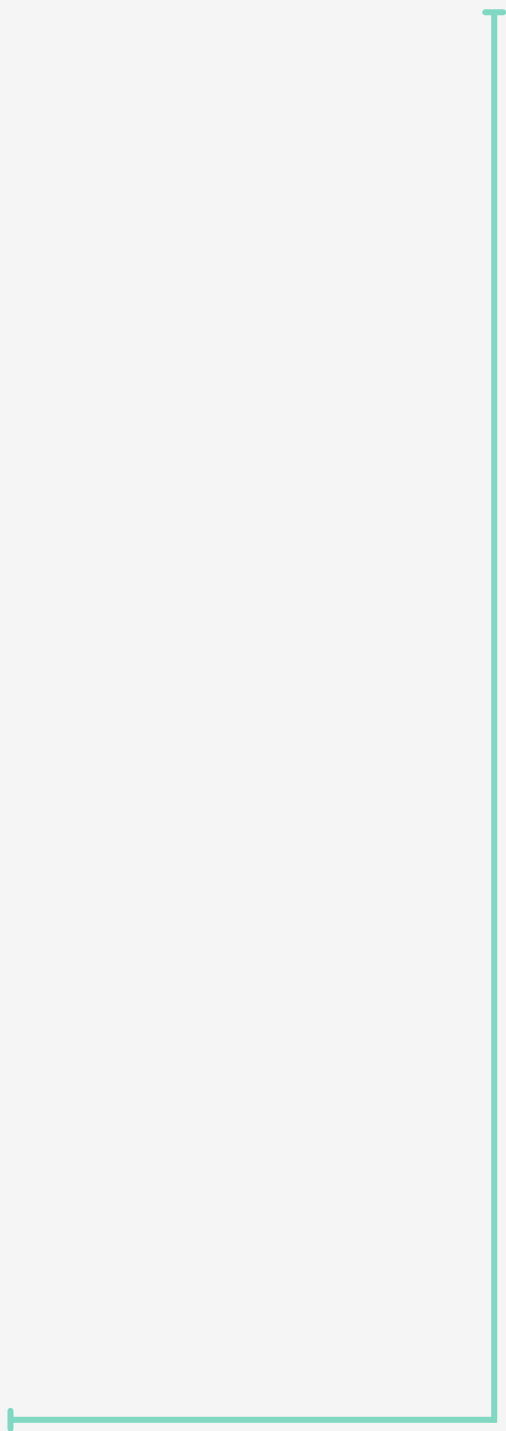
- What do you normally build your identity around?
- What voices most shape the way you see yourself?
- Why do you think people struggle so much with identity?
- How does this passage change the way you see Jesus?
- How should knowing who Jesus is change the way you see yourself?

Challenge

Today, pay attention to where you look for identity. Every time you feel pressure to find worth in approval, appearance, success, or relationships, stop and remind yourself: "My identity starts with surrender to Jesus." Surrender is how we can really know who Christ is. The point of surrender is when you begin to understand who you are.

TUESDAY: FACE TIME

Day 2: Identity through Obedience - Read Philippians 2:6-11

Philippians 2:6-7

Jesus had every right to exalt Himself, yet He chose humility instead. He emptied himself through addition... taking on humanity NOT through subtraction... giving away his divinity. Jesus is God. He cannot stop being God. Again, he empties by adding humanity! The world says identity comes through being noticed, being admired, being first, or getting your own way. Jesus shows the opposite. True greatness is found in humble obedience.

Philippians 2:8

This is the center of the passage. Jesus obeyed the Father completely, even when obedience became painful and costly. Where Adam failed, Christ obeyed. Where humanity rebels, Jesus submits. The Son of Man becomes the perfect representative that mankind could never be on its own.

Philippians 2:9-11

Because of Christ's obedience, God exalted Him above every name. The path to glory came through humility. The path to exaltation came through radical obedience!

Think About It

- What does this passage teach about true greatness?
- Why do people naturally resist obedience and surrender?
- In what areas of your life are you tempted to put yourself first?
- How does Jesus completely redefine strength and identity in this passage?
- If Jesus obeyed the Father at such great cost, what should our response to Him be?

Challenge

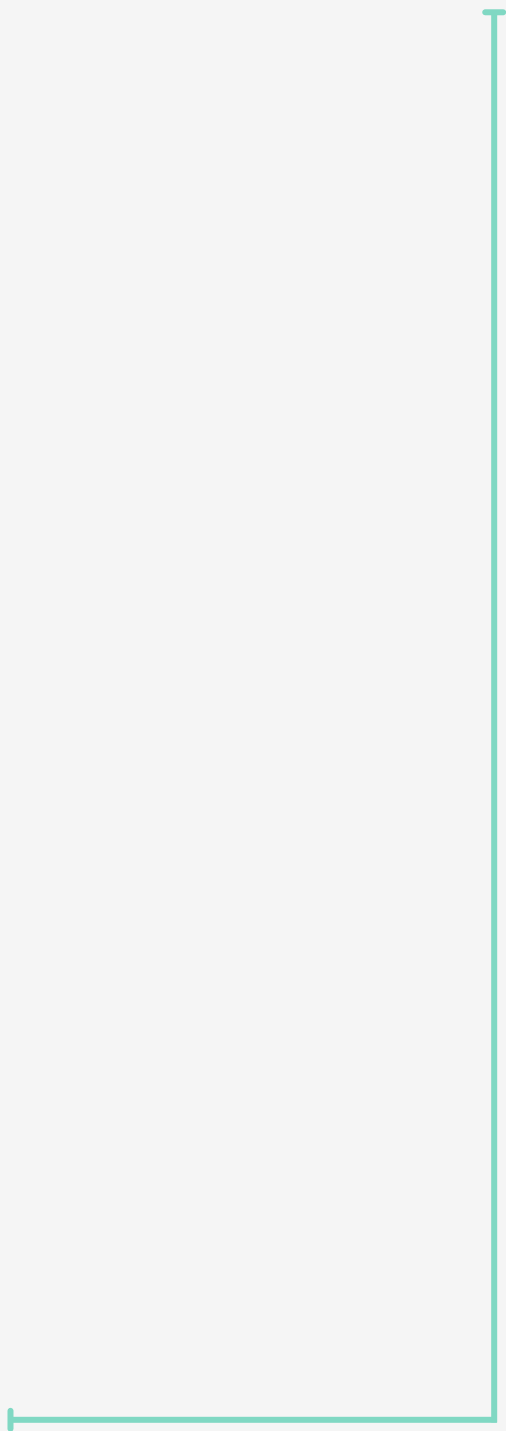
Today, obey God in one area where you have been resisting Him. Maybe it is:

- confessing sin
- forgiving someone
- honoring your parents
- walking away from temptation
- sharing your faith
- spending time with God

Real identity is not found in exalting yourself. It is found in following the obedient Son of Man.

WEDNESDAY: FACE TIME

Day 3: Identity through Allegiance - Read Hebrews 1:1-4

Hebrews 1:1-2

Hebrews begins by showing that Jesus is the final and fullest revelation of God. He perfectly represents God because He is the Son of God. Adam, Israel, and David each failed to represent God to the world. Every human representative eventually fractured their loyalty to God. But Jesus never did.

Hebrews 1:2-3

Jesus is not only God's representative. He is divine Himself. Hebrews says:

- He created the world
- He upholds the universe
- He radiates God's glory
- He perfectly reveals God's nature

Jesus is the faithful Son humanity could never become on its own. He shows us what perfect allegiance to the Father actually looks like.

Hebrews 1:3

The faithful Son gave Himself to rescue unfaithful people. Jesus remained loyal to the Father even to the point of suffering and death. Then He sat down at the Father's right hand, the position of supreme authority and victory.

Hebrews 1:4

Jesus stands above every other authority, messenger, or power. He alone deserves ultimate allegiance. Not divided loyalty or partial devotion, but radical allegiance.

Think About It

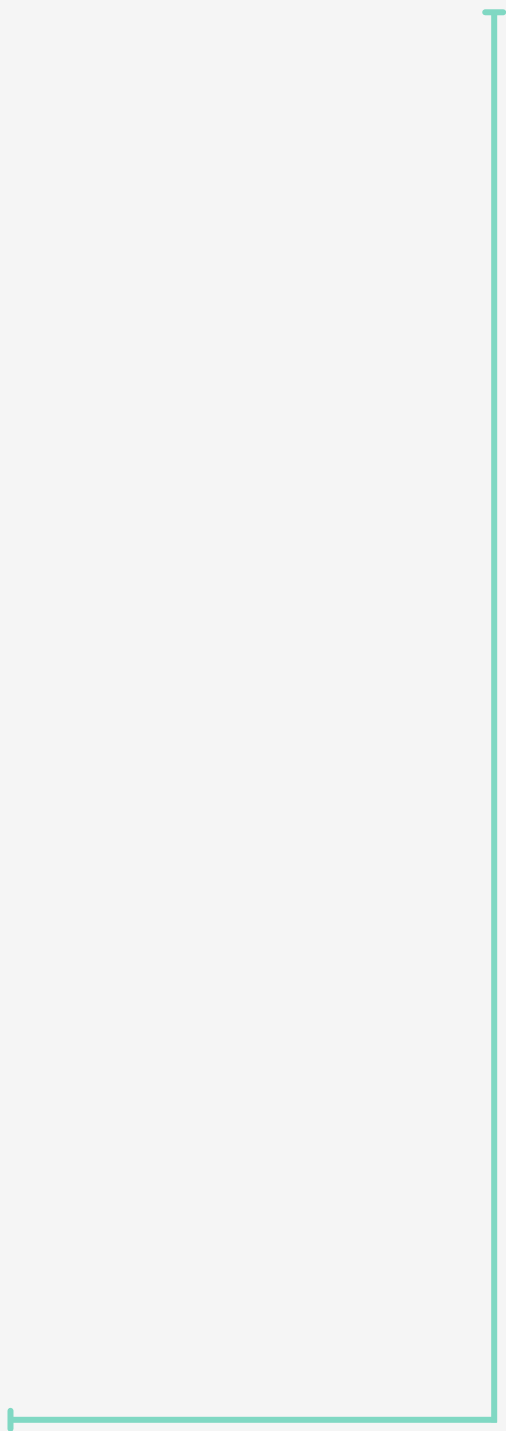
- What does this passage teach about who Jesus really is?
- Why do people so often give their loyalty to things other than God?
- What competes for your allegiance the most?
- Are there areas where your loyalty to Jesus is divided?
- If Jesus perfectly represents God, what should your response to Him be?

Challenge

Pay attention today to what most controls your heart and attention. Whatever has your deepest loyalty will shape your identity. So ask yourself honestly: "Does Jesus truly have my allegiance?" Not just emotionally. Not just at camp. Every day.

THURSDAY: FACE TIME

Day 4: Identity through Worship - Read Ephesians 1:3-14

Ephesians 1:3-6

Paul begins with worship. Before he tells believers what to do, he reminds them of what God has done. In Christ, God has blessed us, chosen us, adopted us, and shown us grace. Worship begins when we remember that our identity is not earned. It is received from God through Christ. Theological note: We are chosen in Christ! God made a choice in eternity past to save those who believe in Christ. People are NOT chosen outside of Christ. That's silly. God doesn't choose people irrespective of their decision to follow Christ! Paul wasn't a Calvinist; you shouldn't be one either.

Ephesians 1:7-10

Jesus is not only the one who blesses us. He redeems us. Through His blood, we have forgiveness. God's plan is to unite all things in Christ. That means Jesus is the center of everything. If Jesus is the center of God's plan, He should be the center of our whole life... that's worship.

Ephesians 1:11-12

In Christ, we belong to God and receive an inheritance from Him. Paul says this happens "to the praise of his glory." In other words, salvation is meant to turn our hearts toward worship. God saves us so that our lives would display His greatness.

Ephesians 1:13-14

The Holy Spirit marks believers as belonging to God. You are not abandoned. You are not forgotten. You are sealed, kept, and secured by God Himself. That should lead us to worship with confidence, gratitude, and surrender.

Think About It

- What does this passage say God has done for believers in Christ?
- Why does Paul keep repeating phrases like "in Christ" and "in him"?
- What do you usually give your attention, affection, and devotion to?
- How does knowing what God has done for you change the way you worship?
- If Jesus truly is Lord, what would radical worship look like in your daily life?

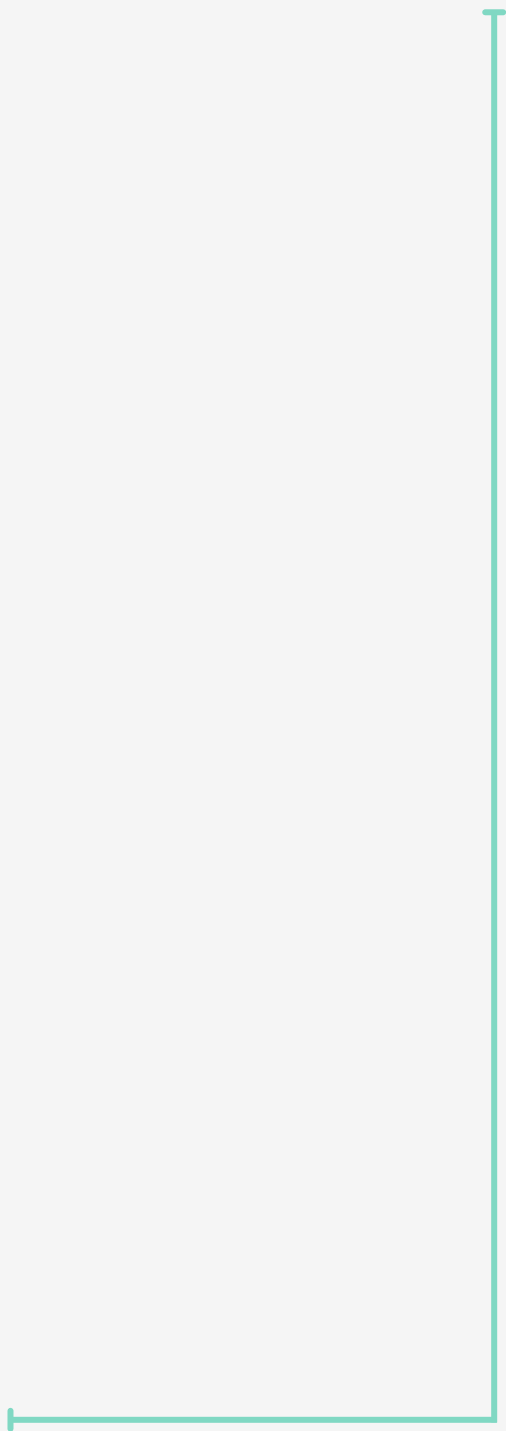
Challenge

Today, worship Jesus with more than a song. Worship Him with your attention. Worship Him with your obedience. Worship Him with your choices. Worship Him with your whole life. Because Jesus is Lord, He deserves more than a moment of worship. He deserves all of you.

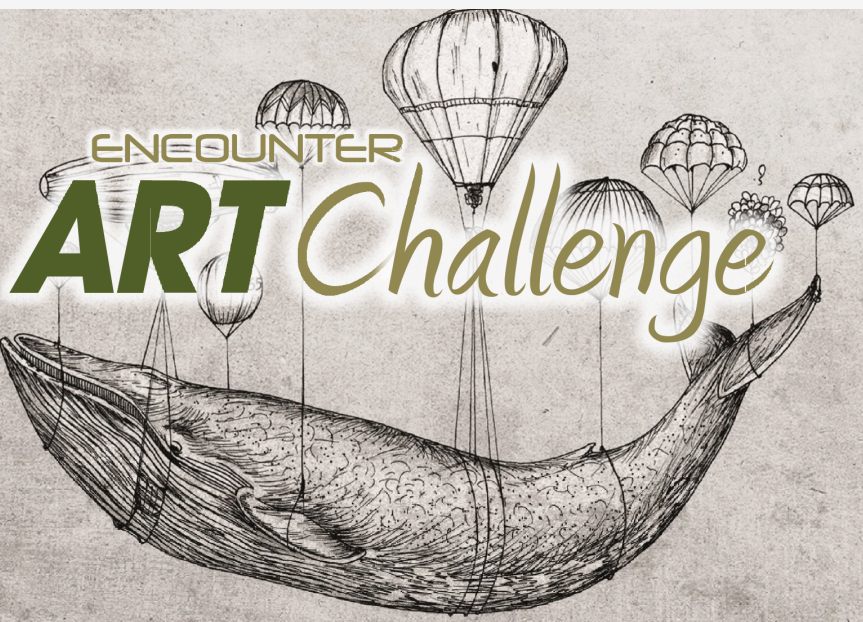

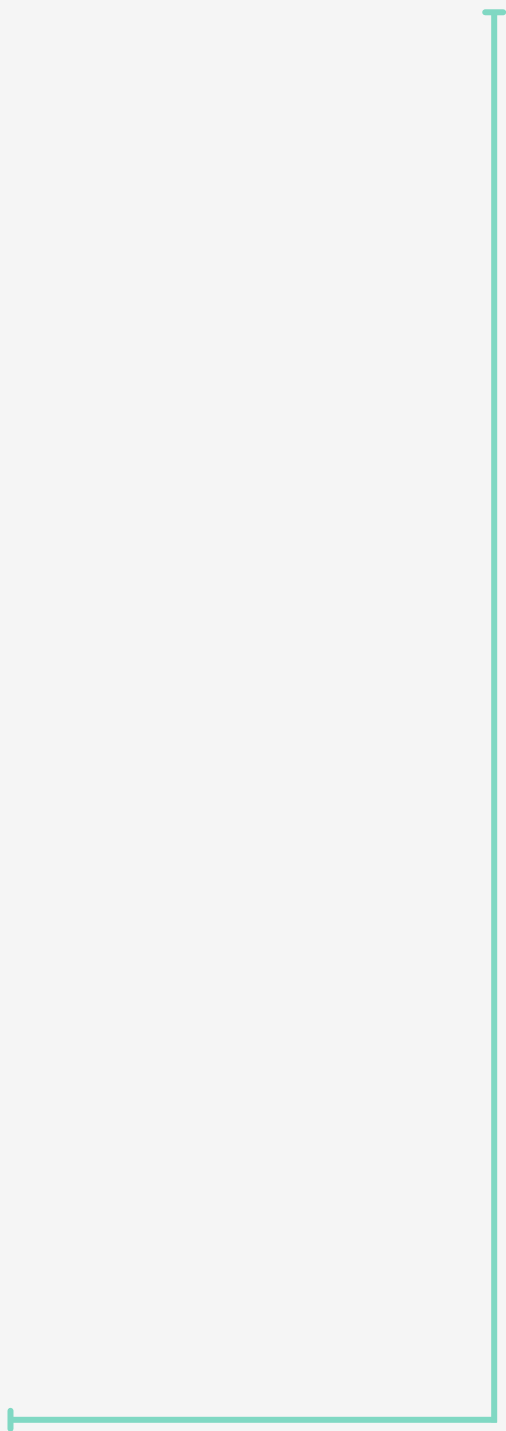

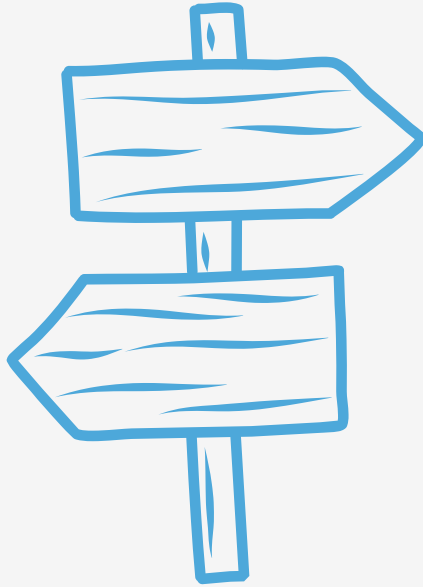
A WORD FROM OUR BOARD:
